

Dr. Sonia Reverter Bañón is Associate Professor of Philosophy in the Department of Philosophy and Sociology at the Universitat Jaume I in Castellon de la Plana. Professor Reverter teaches courses on the philosophical theory of Europe, as well as other courses in Contemporary Philosophy and Feminist Theory. Much of her early scholarly work has been on John Searle's work on the philosophy of language.

Professor Reverter is a member of the Feminist Research Seminar at Universitat Jaume I where her work has been centered on feminist theory, gender violence, the politics of difference, and multiculturalism and identity in the European context. She has been the editor of several special issues of the journal *Asparkía*, one of the leading feminist journals in Spain. She is co-editor of the philosophy journal *Recerca*, for which she prepared the 2006 issue on *Thinking Europe*. She has published some edited volumes on the *Philosophical Theory of Europe*, and *Basic Values of European Identity*. She has authored a book titled *Europa a través de sus ideas*, where she searches the idea of Europe through history. She is currently working on a book on "Feminist Theory in the European Context" to be published later this year. She has also lectured extensively on philosophy, European Identity, gender and violence in Spain and various cities in Europe, the United States, Mexico, Brasil and Argentina and has also been a visiting scholar at institutions in Austria, Denmark, Ireland, Great Britain, Mexico, and the United States.
